

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE

- Terms of payment to approved credit customers are payment in full by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month of delivery. In the absence of pre-approved credit, all deliveries will be COD.
- Credit Card payments are only accepted at time of delivery. Credit Card payments on account may be subject to a 3% additional processing fee.
- Lack of purchase order or job numbers do not affect the terms of sale.
- Ferndale exercises Materialman's Notices on all deliveries.
- Should legal action be necessary to collect whether or not a suit be instituted, Ferndale shall be entitled to reasonable attorney fees and costs, including appeals, bankruptcies, and post-judgement collection efforts.
- Ferndale does not guarantee on-time service for same day orders, time changes, or increased ordered quantities.
- Standby time will be charged at a rate of \$130.00/hour. Five minutes are allowed on site to unload material. An additional 5 minutes on site are allowed for reloading of export materials if required.
- Quotes are valid for 60 days from the posted date.

CHARGES

- Pricing is effective 6:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. After hour pit charges include a \$250.00 minimum opening fee plus \$1.50/ton. All after hour rates will be charged at a time and a half (\$375.00, \$2.25/ton) during Saturday day times, double (\$500.00, \$3.00/ton) for Saturday evening or Sundays, and triple (\$750.00, \$4.50/ton) for any holiday or holiday weekend deliveries.
- Minimum load charge will be 12 tons.
- Materials based on truck & trailer or side dump deliveries. Truck & Transfer deliveries add \$1.00/ton. For solo deliveries add \$3.00/ton.
- Fuel surcharges will be applied on all delivered materials. Fuel surcharges are based the Energy Information Administration ([www.eia.gov](http://www.eia.gov)) Ultra Low Sulfur fuel rate. Fuel surcharges are applied and increased by \$2.50/load per each \$0.25/gallon increase over \$2.50/gallon (e.g. \$2.50/gallon published price has a \$2.50/load fuel surcharge; \$3.50/gallon published price has a \$12.50/load fuel surcharge applied). Point Robert's fuel surcharge rates double.
- This quote is effective for all published Whatcom County and State of Washington prevailing wage rate jobs within Whatcom County. If Federal prevailing wages are required, extra charges will apply. Delivered prices apply to materials dumped in a stockpile only. An additional \$1.50/ton will apply for non stockpiled material deliveries.
- Contractors are responsible to provide flagging for ingress/egress of trucks from public roadways as well as traffic control on the roadway in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (WAC 468-95) and WSDOT Work Zone Traffic Control Guidelines (RCW 47.36).

- Sampling and testing of materials must be done in accordance with the ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) standards, latest revision.
- All gradation, sieve, or Proctor tests will be performed only by a laboratory which is a currently certified by WABO (Washington Association of Building Officials) and A2LA (American Association of Laboratory Accreditation) or AASHTO (American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials).
- Only a laboratory with a Troxler Certification must perform all compaction tests.
- Ferndale Ready Mix & Gravel reserves the right to observe sampling at the job site and testing at the testing agency's laboratory.
- Reports of all test results will be sent to Ferndale Ready Mix & Gravel at the same time and in the same manner as those made to the Architect, Engineer, Owner, and Contractor.
- Ferndale Ready Mix & Gravel is not responsible for the quality or the condition of the subgrade upon which the gravel is to be placed.
- All gravel must be placed only by an experienced contractor.
- Ferndale Ready Mix & Gravel is not responsible for damages of property on deliveries inside the curb line.
- Property owner or contractor must provide an area for gravel trucks to transfer, stage, or park trailers on. Ferndale Ready Mix & Gravel is not responsible for damages to property when directed to transfer, stage, or park trailers on adjacent property or public right of way where permission has not been previously granted to owner or contractor.
